 - LYL Month Wrap Up
 - o Required LYL Month tally was reported to ACLA on 10/17/23
 - o 2023 final amount raised \$11,449.50
 - 62.2% increase in funds raised from 2022 (\$7.058.94)
 - \$4,983 from 2023 Annual Appeal Campaign in September



- 65 donors with 10 new donors for 2023
- All funds eligible for pro-rated match
- Jack Buncher Matching Funds will be announced in December and distributed in 2024
- General Operations & Personnel
 - o Plan for Use of State Aid due to ACLA & OCL by November 21st
 - State report statistics will be forthcoming and should open in the New Year
 - This is will be shared with the public & the Twp Supervisors in the beginning of 2024
- 2024 Budgeting
 - RAD formula for 2024 is frozen, but RAD Board did improve a 4% increase across the board for public libraries
 - Still looking at a 40% increase in new computer equipment and an almost 200% increase in Microsoft licensing
 - Planning to lower the number of public computers to help balance increased costs
 - Waiting on firm numbers for all budget areas coming from the state, including Table Gaming Funds

Suggest passing a draft budget at November meeting and adjusting as needed in December with additional votes
